

Covid-Aware 2020 Season Rules for the ACA Camp at Lake Sebago

These are guidelines for your use of the camp. We are not assuring you that the camp is safe. You can make your own determination whether the use of camp is safe and if you wish to visit. These guidelines are in effect based on our current knowledge of the situation. We will change them as circumstances and guidance from outside organizations change.

1. Remember: stay home if you are sick or have been sick recently.
2. Members should maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from one another, except for those who live in a common household, whether indoors or outside. Any time that individuals must come within 6 feet of another person, acceptable face coverings should be worn.
3. Picnic tables around camp and tables in the Pavilion may only be shared by members of the same household; and you must wipe them with disinfectant after you use them.
4. Maintaining a 6-foot distance from other households is required on the swim dock and in the shallow and deep water areas. No masks may be worn while in the water, but should be worn on the dock. During busy times, the lifeguard may request visitors limit their time lounging or swimming.
5. Please use the hand sanitizer provided before you enter the swimming area.
6. One boat at a time may launch from the boat-launching docks. Maintain a 6-foot distance from others on the docks.
7. No guests who are not ACA members will be allowed in camp this season.
8. No events, whether on land or on water, will be allowed this season.
9. No gatherings of more than 10 people are allowed in camp, outdoors or indoors.
10. Shared equipment must be cleaned and sanitized after use, and between each user.
11. Bathroom rules:
 - a. One person at a time will be allowed in each gender-specific area of the bathrooms.
 - b. Wash your hands frequently throughout the day.
 - c. Masks must be worn when in the bathroom, except for showering.
 - d. Wipe down all surfaces touched, using the disinfectant spray or disinfectant wipes provided.
 - e. A commercial cleaning service will be engaged before and after each weekend to thoroughly clean and disinfect the bathrooms.
